There's a **Candidate Forum for Lawton Ward Council-persons for Wards 3, 4 and 5** tonight (Wednesday, June 1) at 6 pm at the Lawton City Hall auditorium, at SW 9th & C Ave. Please attend and root for our Democrats: Derek Berry in Ward 3 and in Ward 4 we have two Democrats: Jay Burk, the incumbent, and Barbara Curry. There is no Democrat running in Ward 5.

Ward 3 contains the following precincts: 8 and most of 17 (except for the NW corner,

which belongs to Ward 1).

Ward 4 contains the following precincts: 31, 33, and 34.

Ward 5 contains the following precincts: 20, 21 & 27.

Your voter registration card will tell you which precinct you're in. Look for a six-digit number beginning with "16" (which is Comanche County's number) and ending with either a one or two digit number, which is your precinct number.

The election for these Ward positions is June 28. This is also the primary for state representatives and state senators and other state and federal offices where there are contests between two or more Democrats or two or more Republicans. Actually, this time there is also a contest on the Libertarian ballot as well. We have full lists of all the candidates at the office if you'd like to pick up one.

Voter registration is about to end for those who need to be newly registered before the June 28 primary. Voter registration ends at 5 pm this Friday, June 3. New voter registration will begin again after the primary election.

Don't forget: there will **NOT** be a Cornbread and Beans Lunch this Friday, June 3, as that is only one day before the picnic

Also, our **next monthly meeting is Monday, June 20, 2016 at 6 pm at the Great Plains Tech Center, 4500 SW Lee Blvd., Lawton, in Building 100, Room 118 (the auditorium).** Despite my dismal record at actually getting speakers to attend when they promised to do so, **Rep.
